

As we share this common bread and wine, made holy by You, our God, we remember the Last Supper where Jesus ate with His best friends. When He shared the bread He took it and blessed it and said:

This is my blood which I shed because I love you and all of God's children. Whenever you share it, remember me.

Heavenly Father, send Your Holy Spirit upon these gifts that they may be for us, Jesus' new friends, the same as it was for His old friends, so that we might remember how much He loves us today just as He loved His friends so long ago. All this we ask through Your Son, Jesus Christ. Amen.
